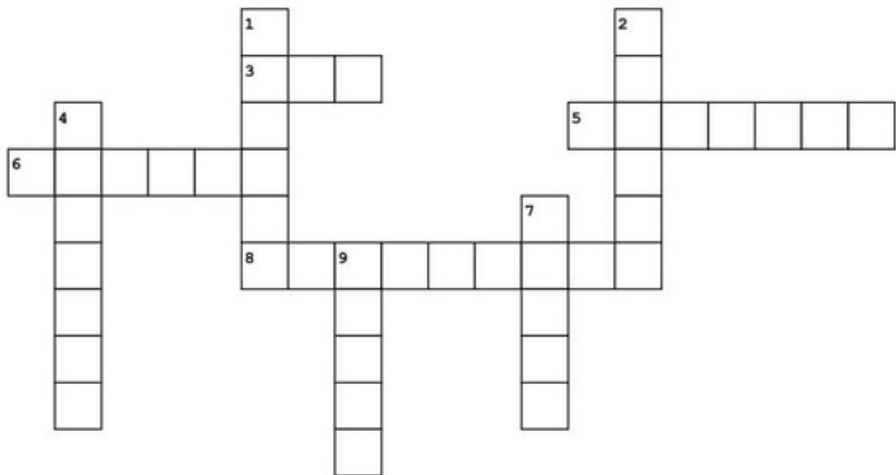

Three little pigs; The wolf's version

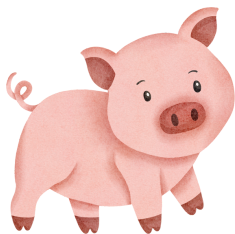

DAY.

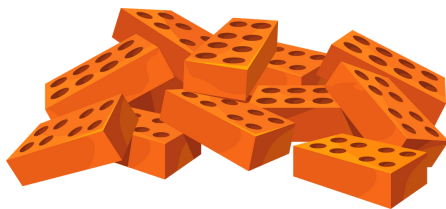
I DECIDED THAT I SHOULD GO IN THROUGH THE CHIMNEY,

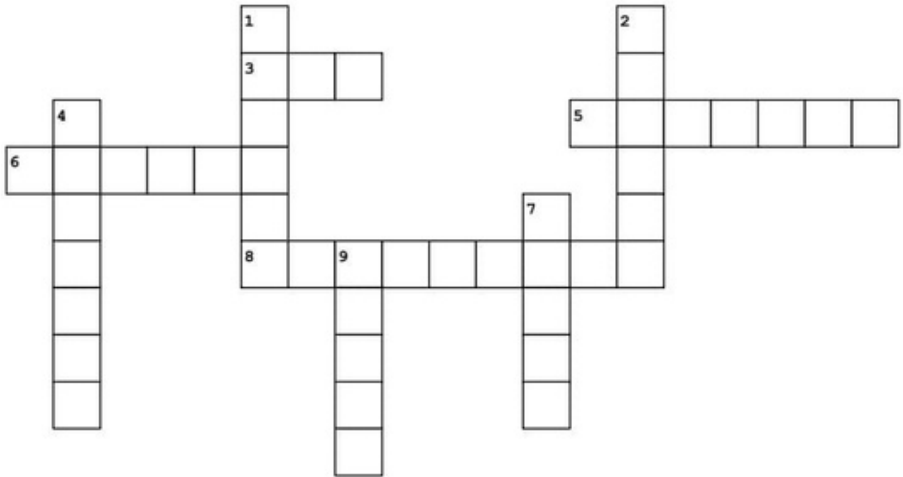

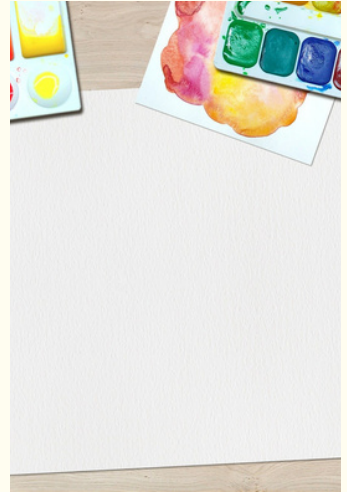
