















MOVIE REVIEW

Taking Care of Me: Fighting the cold

During winter, it's important to keep yourself protected against illnesses that might find their way into your body without you being aware. Here are some top tips on how to stay healthy and warm.

Tip 1: Always layer up both inside and outside. You can do this by wearing jumpers and shirts over your torso, before continuing to add on a thick coat. It may seem a bit extra, but by doing this, you may not even realise the temperature outside.

Tip 2: To avoid getting a cold, wash your hands regularly with soap and warm water. Try to not touch your eyes and nose too much and steer clear of cold and chilled drinks.

Tip-3: You can stay warm by drinking hot and warm drinks such as tea or cocoa. You can try herbal teas with honey, such as lemon and ginger. Add a spoonful of honey and drink it whilst it's hot.


